Terms of Agreement

In order to enhance the development of SEQ Female Under 18 players once they attain the age of 18 years, the following agreement terms are outlined below:

1. Player Commitment:

The following outlines the player commitment required in order to effectively participate within the SEQW Senior competition for 2020.

- **Age Eligibility** – the player must have attained the age of 18 years prior to competing in a SEQW Female competition fixture as per QRL Rule 4.1.3.
- **SEQG Under 18 Club** – Is required to split squad into multiple affiliate clubs (e.g. If two affiliate clubs, split 50/50) via completion of *Appendix 1 Player Allocation*.
- **Permits** – The SEQG Under 18 Club will be responsible for permitting the allocated players to their affiliated SEQW Senior Club via MySideline.

2. Recruitment of Key Club Roles and Coaches:

It is encouraged that the SEQW Senior Club jointly recruit the roles (if agreed and required) as per the requirements of the SEQG Under 18 Competition:

- Head Coach
- Sports Trainer
- Leaguesafe Trainer

3. Governance Requirements:

- Reporting requirements on the partnership/agreement as per the QRL guidelines
- Regular reviews of competition and affiliation partnership will be monitored from time to time
- All clubs to review the QRL policies that currently support the SEQG Under 18 Competition
